### **Responsibilities and Experience:**

Fred is responsible for conducting property surveys, topographic surveys, boundary surveys, certified ALTA surveys and construction layout for sanitary, storm sewer, roads and column steel. He has been surveying for **45 years** with Yerkes Associates, surpassing his Father (deceased) who served 44 years with Yerkes.

He started working at Yerkes at the age of 19 on April 26, 1976, working under his Dad, Roland D'Ortone, then Yerkes Chief Surveyor. 2021 marks Fred's 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary of service. Roland completed a (44) year career with Yerkes starting around 1956. Considering the start of Roland, there has been a D'Ortone at Yerkes for 66 years.

Also of note, for more than three years, Fred has traveled with the survey crew to the Marcellus Shale region where GPS and total station equipment was used to survey both public and private boundaries, along with farmland and natural gas utility pads.
